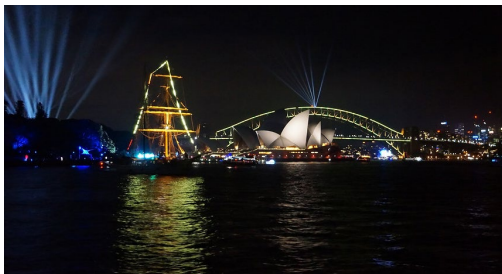
19 – 22 May 22 Sanctuary Cove International Boat Show

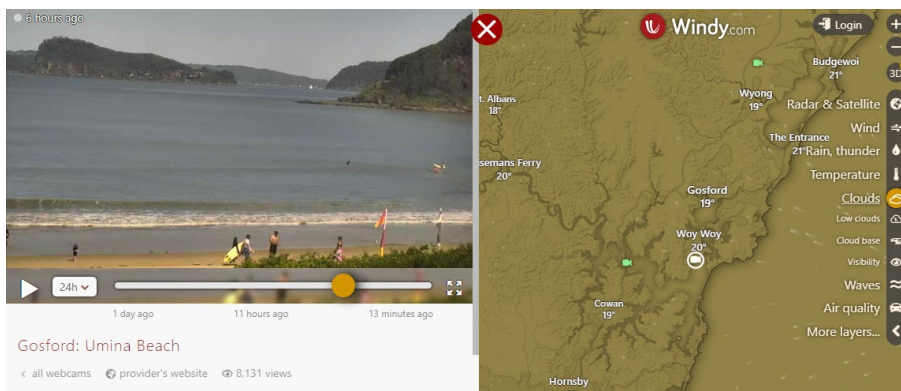
Monthly Committee Meetings
